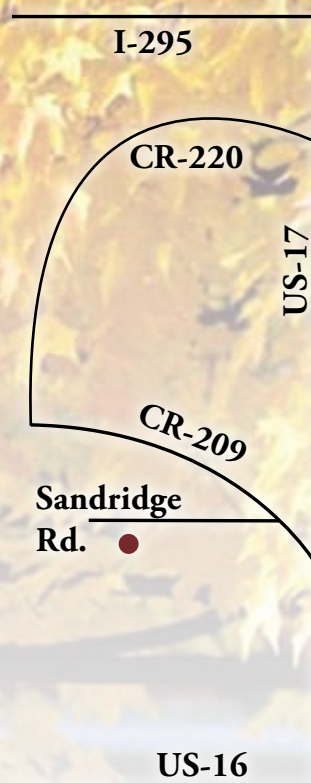

Favorite recipes from Anna's kitchen

Recipe - Braised Beef Short Ribs

Ingredients

2 ½ lbs. beef short ribs

3tbs. olive oil

2tbs. soy sauce

1 medium yellow onion, sliced

4 cloves of garlic, chopped

1/3c. Worcestershire sauce

1/3c. brown sugar

6-8c. water

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.

Place a dutch oven on the stove. Season short ribs with salt, pepper and garlic powder. Add oil and sear ribs on all sides over medium-high heat. Add the soy sauce, onion, garlic, Worcestershire sauce, brown sugar, and water to the dutch oven, and bring to a simmer over medium-high heat. Adjust the seasoning, to taste, and tightly cover, and transfer to the oven. Cook until the ribs are tender and fall from the bones, about 3 to 3 1/2 hours.

We like to serve these short ribs with polenta or mashed potatoes with the cooking liquid spooned over the top. You can also cook these in a crock pot, but I prefer the dutch oven. I love my cast iron!
